Funds from the Trust are intended to assist the elderly and those whose needs are great, to facilitate accessibility for persons with disabilities, and to support specific outreach programs in the diocese. Program requests will be given first consideration. Capital requests may be reviewed if there are undistributed funds available. The Dandridge Trust accepts grant requests each fall for funding in the following year. Charitable organizations within the Diocese of Tennessee are now invited to submit grant applications to the Dandridge Trust for 2024.
